

#### **Looking Back and Looking Forward**

A little over a week, we (the whole world) celebrated the beginning of a new year, 2015 (I still can't believe it's 2015.). As people the world over stood in the space in between two years, they looked back and reflected upon their lives up to that point and looked forward with new resolutions, new hopes, new dreams for what is to come.

Last Sunday, many within the universal Church celebrated Epiphany Sunday, the Sunday on which we remember that the wise men/magi/kings visited the boy Jesus and recognized him as the Messiah, the New King. (We will have our epiphany celebration this coming Sunday.) And Epiphany Sunday should be just as much - if not more - a time of looking back (reflecting) and looking forward (dreaming or visioning into the future) as the change from one year to the next.

Poet T.S. Eliot wrote as much in his poem, "Journey of the Magi". Reflecting on the journey to and from the Christ child, one of the magi reflects:

Were we led all that way for

Birth or Death? There was a Birth, certainly,

We had evidence and no doubt. I had seen birth and death,

But had thought they were different; this Birth was

Hard and bitter agony for us, like Death, our death.

We returned to our places, these Kingdoms,

But no longer at ease here, on the old dispensation,

With an alien people clutching their gods.

I should be glad of another death.

We have remembered and celebrated the birth of Jesus, the coming of the Messiah, to us. Such remembrance and celebration should change us, individually and as a congregation.

The year 2014 was a good year for us, a GREAT year. We worked as a congregation toward living into this amazing vision/identity God has for us as a congregation to and for adults 50+ in the Grand Valley. Your committees/ministries implemented a number of new, important, and vital ministries.

The year 2014 was the first of our years of implementing new ministries and GROWING into what God desires from us and for us! The year 2015 can and should be an even bigger year in that direction.

Individually, please prayerfully consider how God is calling YOU to be a part of what God is doing HERE.
