

What is it That Unites Us?

"As members of the Christian Church, We confess that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God...

We rejoice in God, maker of heaven and earth, and in God's covenant of love which binds us to God and to one another...

In the bonds of Christian faith we yield ourselves to God that we may serve the One whose kingdom has no end."

-excerpts from The Design of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ)

I'm in the midst of spending time preparing a New Member's Class, a class designed to inform recent and prospective members about our denomination and our congregation. As I prepare the class, I am diving in again to the fascinating history of the Restoration Movement, a movement that led to the formation of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ.)

As Disciples, the ideal of Christian Unity is part of our DNA; it is what former General Minister and President of the CC(DOC) Kenneth Teagarden called, "the distinctive cause that has been [our] reason for existing." However, to say that unity is so important to us is to tell only half of the story. The other half identifies what it is that unites us. After all, every social club, every country club, and every organization in existence has some source of unity. As the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ), the source of our unity - the impetus for our unity - must be something specific. Can we say that we're part of the CC (DOC) simply because we enjoy fellowship with one another or because we like to serve meals together or because we have known each other for decades? Can we say that any of these are the source of our unity? I hope you recognize that the answer is "no," that the answer MUST be "no".

The answer, the source of our unity, must be Christ; it must be getting to know Christ and following Christ over and above anything, everything, else. We must be united behind giving up our own wills and allowing God's will. In order to be Church, we must "yield ourselves to God" and "serve the One whose kingdom has no end." That is the source of our unity.
