

Some Thoughts On Being a Congregation

This past Sunday, First Christian Church, Grand Junction worshipped in two different locations: the Kagie Center up on a mountain/mesa above Glade Park and the church building located at 1326 North 1st Street in Grand Junction. As I worshipped – and led worship – at the Kagie Center, I had thoughts go through my mind that I hadn't anticipated:

- First and foremost, my thoughts focused on God and my encounter with God in that time and that mountaintop place, which was different than my encounters with God inside the walls of a church building;
- My mind wandered back to the results of a decision by another congregation to move from offering one worship service to offering two worship services of different styles, one of the results being that some members of the congregation felt that the congregation had become divided/split as a result of the change;
- My mind drifted into the future, envisioning more worship services on the mountaintop with more traditional hymns in the bluegrass style;
- My mind drifted down the mountain to the building on 1st Street, and I felt a strong connection with those who were worshipping there, and I prayed that they were experiencing God in that moment, as well;
- My mind drifted to Acts 2:43-27, my favorite biblical description of the early church, and I was amazed at how it felt like we were living into that description up on that mountain (with a few notable exceptions, one of them being that all the believers were not "together"...or were they?);

I'm not sure where your mind wandered when you worshipped this past Sunday. Hopefully, you kept your focus on God in those moments of worship. However, if your mind, like mine, wandered to some other places, I would encourage you to begin a dialog with me and with the other leaders of First Christian Church, Grand Junction (especially with members of the Worship Committee). I encourage this discussion because I believe something important happened in the planning for and during these two worship services. I believe that we discovered some things about being a congregation. Hopefully, we learned that being a congregation has more to do with our hearts and minds and souls and our kinship in Christ (belief and actions) than it has to do with our physical proximity to every other member of the congregation on a given Sunday.
