

A Conversation We Need to Have: Church Size Theory

Let me begin with a story: I once approached the leadership of a congregation and shared with them some research about something called "church size theory." Church size theory suggests that the size of a congregation is a key determinant of a congregation's culture, governance structure, and resource allocation decisions. Church size theory also suggests that there are 4 types of congregations, based on church size. Church size theory further suggests that different people encounter God best in congregations of different sizes/types of congregations. I approached the leadership of the congregation to talk about church size theory because I sensed a strong difference of opinion among the leaders with regard to which size of congregation each leader desired that congregation to be. After we discussed the various sizes of congregations and took a blind vote to determine which size each leader desired that congregation to become, we found that exactly one third of the leaders had a strong preference for each (of three different) size(s). It turns out, this was the underlying conflict that had been troubling the congregation for decades. Once we got that on the table, the congregation was able to begin a very helpful dialog that led to significant spiritual growth within the congregation.

I tell you this story for a reason. This Sunday, I am going to begin a conversation about church size theory with the Cabinet of this congregation, but I don't want the conversation to end with the Cabinet. I am going to encourage the committee chairpeople of this congregation to engage you in a dialog about the direction we believe God is calling this congregation (with regard to size) so that we can honestly talk about how we feel about it.

In every congregation I have served, there is at first a unanimous agreement that the congregation should grow in number. However, there is much less unanimity regarding what comes with numerical growth (for example: new people with new/different ideas about being church, not knowing everybody, not being able to be involved in everything or even in decisionmaking about everything, a sense of losing the identity of your church.) After three years of following Jesus with all of you, I sense that we need to talk about some of these things and determine: (1) whether or not God is calling us to numerical growth, and (2) whether or not we're comfortable with what God is calling us to. We need to talk about these things before we can, as a congregation, invite people in.

By the way, staying the same or even growing smaller has drawbacks, as well. Most notably, there are fewer resources available to pay costs that we may feel "stuck" with (like the maintenance costs of our building) but that are the result of decisions made in past generations when the congregation was (numerically) larger but that impact what we can do today.

Please be in dialog with each other and with me!
