

311,000 Square Miles of Disciples

As a clergyperson attending last weekend's Clergy Convocation and Spring Feast in Colorado Springs, I heard one number repeated over and again, mostly by Dean Phelps. The number is this: 311,000, as in **311,000 square miles of Disciples** in the Central Rocky Mountain Region of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ)...imagine hearing that phrase repeated over and over, as well.

Since I've returned home to Grand Junction, the number 311,000 has been running circles inside my head, and I've been trying to figure out why. Even though Dean (our Interim Regional Minister) repeated the number frequently, his repetition of it just can't be why I keep thinking about it. After all, I hear songs repeated on the radio with great frequency, but only a small fraction of those songs stick with me.

After deep thought, I think I've come up with some reasons why this number is sticking with me (and why it should stick with you, as well.)

First. It's a reminder that **we're part of something physically BIGGER**. In fact, we're a part of something that is about 8,000 times bigger than the area of the city of Grand Junction. If you ever start to feel like the whole task of being Church is on our narrow shoulders, remember, it's NOT. We're part of something bigger.

Second (and related to the first). It's a reminder that **we're not alone**; we are connected to others who share the same calling as us. Whatever struggles we encounter here in Grand Junction to continue Jesus' ministry, there are others who have been called in the same way we have been called and some of them are likely experiencing the same struggles. Let's call upon their strength and experience when we need them.

Third (and related to the first). It's a reminder that we have something to offer outside our own little place in the world. As congregation, it's easy to narrow our focus down to this town or even our own church building. 311,000 calls us to lift our heads up and look beyond, recognizing that God is sending us out beyond our own narrow gaze. We are gifted to continue Jesus' ministry, here...and beyond.

Fourth (and related to the first). It's a sign of hope. The original disciples had hope that God would provide a harvest if they planted the seeds. As their spiritual heirs, we benefit from knowing that God really did provide a harvest. God's promise has proven true. Let the fulfillment of this promise provide us hope as we sow seeds.

I'm sure 311,000 means more than just these four things. In fact, I can think of quite a few more as I write these words. I challenge you to consider how 311,000 informs, shapes, and encourages your ministry as a follower of Jesus.

Sunday School


<u>10:00 AM Sunday School Class</u>: Gospel of John discussions with coffee and donuts.
