

## "A Party Called Faith"

As our Evangelism Sermon Series nears its close, I look forward to seeing how God transforms us by these sermons. I look forward to working together with all of you to:

- Pray and listen in prayer about God's desires for the growth of this congregation;
- Discover the story each of you have to share, the story of how the love of God as made known in Jesus has made a difference in your life;
- Grow in our relationships with God, with people outside the congregation, and with people inside the congregation;

As I work on the series, I am reminded of the congregation into which I was baptized as a teen and watching the elders at the Communion Table look so serious, stoic, and even sad, never happy or celebratory. I am reminded of that image as I read about God commanding - yes commanding - God's people to partake of regular festivals and as I read about God setting up a regular calendar of celebration in the Bible. It's time for us to re-discover the celebratory aspects of our faith.



#### **El Salvador Update**

DeeAnn and Clayton Lowry, and John and I are eagerly looking forward to our August mission trip to El Salvador. Because there are four from our church, and twelve all together, we are hoping to pack some suitcases full of needed supplies to take to the adults and children in the impoverished area we will be working in. We need basic medical supplies--especially pain relievers and vitamins (childrens, prenatal or multi vitamins for adults). They always need first aid supplies such as bandages, Neosporin, etc. We also always use paintbrushes or rollers. Those things can get heavy so money to buy them when we are there is a way to go also.

We will be working near two schools so can always use basic school supplies. We also work at a preschool so some appropriate things for little ones would be helpful. Barnes and Nobles has Spanish language books. Remember these children know no English so books in English aren't much fun for them. Crayons, scissors, that kind of thing is great.

We will be building two houses while we are there. A generous person from Oklahoma is donating the money for one of them. That leaves fundraisers and donations for the approximately \$3,000 we need to build the other one. Please, please attend the fundraising dinner we are having on July 23 at 5:00 with the silent auction. The dinner will be free with donations accepted for the food itself. The silent auction will have many Salvadoran items to bid on as well as general merchandise. It is always fun to come and see what is available.

Even if you can't attend the dinner, we will be accepting cash donations. Please let me, or the Lowry's know where you want the money to go. We are building a new home for an older couple who live in appalling conditions, sleeping on feed sacks that they move around their dirt floor house depending on the way the wind blows the rain on the leaky roof. We want to build them a dry, weather-proof home and buy them a bed.

Probably our biggest need is money to take for the homes and the needs we see when we are there. Your generosity has always overwhelmed me. We are a famous church in the little village of Las Trincheras.

Financial Summary for the month of May, 2016

Total Income ......\$17,051.58 Total Expense.....\$14,070.63 Net Income.....\$2,890.93
