

#### "What hath God wrought?"

"What hath God wrought?" was the text of the inaugural message, transmitted in Morse code, on the first long-distance telegraph line between Baltimore, MD and Washington, DC in 1844. This Bible verse from Numbers 23:23 expressed the wonder that Samuel Morse felt on that day when he launched the invention that revolutionized modern communication. Today, we might use the more modern words, "See what God has done!" to express our amazement at the wonders of modern technology used to spread God's word.

The church has always been at the forefront of technology. The first book that Johann Gutenberg printed upon the invention of movable type and the printing press in 1455 was the Bible. Early radio programs spread religious shows to the furthest reaches of the country. Churches and denominations were early adopters of the Internet, sound systems and video screens to augment their services. It's hard to imagine or remember what our services were like before we had effective sound amplification, projected lyrics and recorded music to help us receive the weekly message.

Our church, like most modern churches, has a Technology Ministry to install and operate the technical aspects of our church home. The Sunday services are the most visible thing we do, but we also make sure you have your programs and newsletters by maintaining the computers, printers and copier. We also record the sermon on Sunday and assist where required with the Facebook page and website.

Most of our work is behind the scenes on a daily basis. There's an old saying in the tech ministry that says, "If we're doing our job, no one knows we're there." But it still takes people to make the magic happen. We have several people who put the video presentation together every week and it takes a video operator and a sound operator for every service, wedding, funeral, play and presentation.

We're always looking for people who are called to assist in this ministry. Granted, a lot of what we do is somewhat technically challenging, but if you can use your smartphone, log onto the Internet and talk to your grandkids on Facetime or Skype, you just may have more technical talent than you thought!

Please feel free to contact me on any Sunday morning, give me a call or e-mail me if you would like to become a part of this ministry. We'll train you!


