

### How Do You Make Jesus' Identity Known?

We're in the midst of the season of/after the Epiphany. During this season, we focus our attention on the ways God made (and still makes) Jesus' identity known.

In my conversations with people outside the institutional Church, one thing is becoming ever more clear to me: the primary means by which a great many people outside the Church identify Jesus is by watching the lives of those of us who are inside the Church. In other words, YOU/WE followers of Jesus are making Jesus' identity known by the way we follow Jesus, by the way we live our lives

Do you ever wonder who others will understand Jesus to be when they:

- See you driving around town?
- Encounter you at a store?
- Listen to the words you say and how you say them?
- See the things you prioritize in life?
- See the things you purchase?
- Encounter your posts and pictures on social media?

For people who somehow KNOW you're a Christian, a follower of Jesus, every experience they have with you communicates something about Jesus' identity. For a great many people you don't think know you're a Christian, I'm guessing they know more than you think and therefore still receive a message about Jesus' identity from you. And even for the people who absolutely, positively, have no way of knowing you're a Christian, you (and by extension all of us followers of Jesus) communicate something about Jesus' identity by the reality that these folks have no clue who we are. Doesn't it say something about Jesus' identity if Jesus' supposed followers hide this aspect of our identity? Doesn't it say something about Jesus' identity when Jesus' supposed followers don't stand out enough to lend a helping hand to a person in need or to generally pursue the cause of justice? If we are silent or invisible with regard to certain issues, we are communicating that a fundamental part of Jesus' identity is as One who doesn't care about those issues.

My friends, as a follower of Jesus, one of the crucial elements of your choice to follow Jesus is to communicate the identity of the One you follow! I hope and pray you will prayerfully consider what your actions make known about Jesus' identity and that you will then work to make sure what you communicate about Jesus' identity is in synch with who you believe Jesus to be.

### Just a little from the Creation Care group

### **Mesa County Landfill Days are Limited**

Did you have an opportunity to read in the November 26, 2018 *Daily Sentinel* which said that 33 percent of the trash entering the Mesa County Landfill is recyclable? A survey was completed in the spring and again this fall to see what was there! It proved that there is a lot more we can do the improve the situation. Almost 60 percent was recyclable or compostable—we can and must do better—not only for the landfill but for the earth's future.

During the survey, over 600 pounds of trash a day were sorted into 32 different categories, and 60 percent was recyclable or compostable. Apparently cardboard was a big issue. With so many people shopping on line, cardboard boxes are everywhere. Here at FCC we have a tub in the Fellowship Hall by the stage for you to bring those cardboard boxes in to recycle.

The survey showed that another big waste was food. Remember your mother telling you to clean your plate and think of the children in other parts of the world starving to death? Well, that expression holds true today—just think of the starving people in Yemen. All of us can do better by buying only what we can use. You may not be able to help the people in Yemen without making a monetary contribution, but you can help lower the food waste going into our local landfill.

One not so little addition to the landfill are those plastic grocery bags. Worldwide less that a fifth of all plastic gets recycled. In the US it's less than 10 percent. The European Union is finalizing rules that would ban certain single-use plastic items, such as plastic cutlery, Styrofoam cups and most plastic bags. (Source: Science Friday 12/21/18)

We can do our part even before any of the above becomes a requirement in our city, state, nation. Our great grandchildren will be thankful for all that we can do to correct the problem. A quote from a June 2018 article says, "We made plastic, we depend on it and now we are drowning in it." Let's do our best to not go under!

FYI: A dead whale washed up on the beach in Indonesia had 15 pounds of plastic in its belly: 115 plastic cups, four plastic water bottles, 25 plastic bags, 2 flip-flops, a nylon sack and more than 1,000 other assorted pieces.

I want to change that! I thought that, we as a church, could begin writing our own stories. What I plan to do is include 2 questions per newsletter (which would equate to one question per week for a year) that invite you to talk about yourself and your life. Take time to write down your answers in a journal (I don't really care that your handwriting doesn't look like it used to......if we all used that excuse then none of us would be writing!) or type out your stories or ask someone from church to help you record your stories if you have no other way to express them! The important thing is that you take time to share your answers, your stories! It is my hope that we will have opportunities throughout the year to gather together and share our stories with one another, and in the end we can determine the best way to compile your stories into a book that can be shared with your friends and family! The truth is that we all have a story to tell.

God wants to use each of us, regardless of our age, and maybe just maybe by sharing our stories we will once again listen and learn how God is calling us and we will be able to encourage others as they share their stories!

Week 1: What is your birth story? (What stories were you told about your birth or what did you have to piece together through the years? What was the town/state in which you were born? What type of building were you born in?)

Week 2: Who are your birth and/or adoptive parents? (Do you know much about them or were they quiet and didn't speak much? Do you know anything about how they decided upon having children? What type of work did they do?)




